Cabrillo Symphonic Chorus heads to Las Vegas

DIVISION CONFERENCE

The Cabrillo Symphonic Chorus performs at the Western Division Regional Conference of the American Choral Directors Association this Thursday, February 26, at 11:00 a.m. at the Guardian Angel Cathedral in Las Vegas, Nevada. The program includes:

- Eric Whitacre's "i thank You God," a musical composition of an extract from an e. e. cummings poem of the same title
 - Leonard Bernstein's "Chichester Psalms," a three-movement work composed in 1965 for chorus and orchestra of Psalm 108, verse 2; Psalm 100; Psalm 23; Psalm 2, verses 1-4; Psalm 131; and Psalm 133, verse 1
- Most of the musicians who were our orchestra for the Music for the Feast of

Christmas concerts this past December are accompanying us to Las Vegas. Soloists featured in our Las Vegas program are:

By now, you should all have your Dvorák *Stabat Mater* scores and practice CDs. If you do not have a score, you need to purchase one from our librarian, Leslie Karst, Alto II. If you do not have a practice CD, see your section head for one. The score and CD together are \$20. Make your check out to Cabrillo Chorus and give it to Leslie Karst.

You should also have picked up the errata sheet for your section (or for all four sections) and should have marked your score per these errata. Thank you, Amethyst Ware, Soprano II, for going through Larry Granger's score to create these errata sheets for each section!

Last week, you should have picked up another handout, the translation of the Latin text of *Stabat Mater* into English.
