Come see potential future members of the Cabrillo Symphonic Chorus perform in the Cabrillo Youth Chorus' Autumn Concert this coming Sunday, November 16, at 2 p.m., at the First Congregational Church of Santa Cruz. The church is at 900 High Street on the corner of Moore Street and next to Westlake Elementary School.

The concert takes place in the church's sanctuary, and tickets are only available at the door, with seating being on a first-come-first-seated basis. Admission is \$5 per person or \$10 per family.
