New and returning members should be registered for Music 61, Cabrillo Symphonic Chorus, Section 35041. If you are not already registered in the course, you will need an Add slip signed by Cheryl Anderson. Seek one of these from Leslie Karst, our librarian.

The work we'll be learning this semester and performing with the Santa Cruz County Symphony on May 1 at the Santa Cruz Civic Auditorium is Antonín Dvorák's *Stabat Mater*. New and returning members who have not already

purchased the *Stabat Mater* score and practice CD should do so today. Make your \$20 check out to Cabrillo Chorus and give it to Leslie Karst, who will be selling the scores in front of the left whiteboard as you face the front of the room.

The course start and finish times for Music 61 printed in the Cabrillo Course Catalog are incorrect. Rehearsal every Tuesday begins at 7:00 p.m. sharp. Finish time is 10:00 p.m.

THREE FREE LOCAL
CONCERTS IN FEBRUARY

With less than two weeks before their appearance as the opening chorus of the annual American Choral Directors Association-Western Regional Convention on February 26 in Las Vegas, the group representing the Cabrillo Symphonic Chorus performs no less than three concerts in that time to perfect its performance.

New and returning members not performing in Las Vegas are invited to attend any and all of these three free performances. The first occurs next Tuesday, February 17, at the start of regular rehearsal time, 7:00 p.m., here in the Erica Schilling 450 Forum rehearsal room. The performance takes about 20 minutes and consists of two works:

- Eric Whitacre's "i thank you god"
- Leonard Bernstein's "Chichester Psalms"

Las Vegas performers (wow, we're in a league with Wayne Newton, aren't we?) need to arrive in concert attire next Tuesday. Our audience will include Cabrillo College faculty and staff and other dignitaries.

The next two free local concerts occur the weekend before February 26 and will be with our hired orchestra. The first of these occurs Saturday, February 21, at 6:00 p.m. at the First Congregational Church of Santa Cruz, 900 High Street. Performers, arrive in concert attire at 5:30 p.m.

The last concert is the following day, Sunday, February 22, at 7:30 p.m. at the Resurrection Church of Aptos, 7600 Soquel Ave. Performers, arrive in concert attire at 7:00 p.m.
