- o From 1997 to 1998, reported CCI offenses decreased 13.0 percent in rate per 100,000 . population. The CCI decreased 47.2 percent in rate since 1980.
- o From 1997 to 1998, the violent crime rate decreased 12.2 percent. The violent crime rate has decreased 22.7 percent since 1980.
- o From 1997 to 1998, the property crime rate decreased 13.4 percent. The property crime rate has decreased 54.3 percent since 1980.
