SUSPECT: Unknown


PHYSICAL: Middle Eastern male; 5'9"; medium build; 35 years old; black hair; brown eyes; and dark complexion

CLOTHING: No information available

WEAPON: No information available

VEHICLE: Tan, beige or champagne four-door sedan, possibly a Toyota, Ford, or Pontiac Sunfire

OUTSTANDING FEATURES: Crooked and/or yellow long teeth that were black at the gum line. Moles on left cheek.



INFORMATION: The San Jose Police Department is requesting assistance in identifying a suspect or other similar crimes that may be related to a series of child annoyance/attempted kidnaps that occurred on 12/3/01, 1/17/02, 3/5/02, 3/28/02, and 4/28/02.

MODUS OPERANDI SUMMARY: The suspect approaches young women as they walk alone to their destinations, primarily schools and parks. He will ask each victim for directions and then make sexual comments to them. During two of the incidents, the suspect has exited his vehicle, approached the victim, and demanded that they get into his car. The suspect flees the scene.
