
Terminal

This application provides access to the underlying operation system. (For Experts Only)

Overview

 In the Applications folder of the Home screen, tap the "Terminal" application icon.



1. Perform the desired command.

Font menu	Changes the font size. (Micro, Small Fixed, Medium Fixed)
Return icon	Works as Return key, or executes the command.
Space icon	Works as Space key, or enters a space in the command input area.
Tab icon	Operates as Tab key on the keyboard. (Allows you to display folders and files beginning with a certain character.)
Previous icon	Displays a previous command you executed.
Next icon	Displays a command again executed before tapping the Previous icon.
Paste icon	Pastes text selected in command area
Command drop- down list button	Tap the list to display the frequently used commands and tap one to select it.
Command input area	Enters a command, or displays the command result.

2. Tap III to close the screen to return to the Home screen.

The Terminal application offers the Linux-based basic commands to manage files stored in the unit. Carry out these commands with care so as not to loose or erase important files in the unit system.
